The Tübinger Chalet is situated at 2,191 m in one of the most beautiful valleys in Vorarlberg, nestled between towering cliffs at the end of the Garneratal below the Plattenspitze. The secluded Garneratal is a particularly picturesque valley and is considered an insider tip in the Montafon. The Montafon band 'Krauthobel' has sung of the valley's beauty.

The Tübinger Chalet is a rewarding excursion destination and starting point for various hikes, mountain and climbing tours. In winter, mountaineers also appreciate its location for impressive [ski tours](#).

The rustic winter room is open in winter and provides everything required for the winter season: an oven, a sleeping area with 15 blankets, a toilet and a small emergency supply for those seeking shelter. A cash box is provided for payment.
